

Instructions for the Preparation of Poster Presentations

The text for the poster presentation should be typed in Microsoft Office Word (Times New Roman font, size 14; line spacing - 1; characters and symbols from font sets, including Greek, should be inserted through the "Insert/Symbol" menu).

Five informational blocks (frames) will be displayed on the poster:

I Frame - Presentation title;

II Frame - Authors of the presentation; organization name;

III Frame - Summary (no more than 250 characters);

IV Frame - Introduction, indicating the relevance and novelty (no more than 1135 characters);

V Frame - Main research results (no more than 11,100 characters);

VI Frame - Conclusion (no more than 730 characters).

Information for frame V (research results) should not exceed 11,100 characters. Present the research results sequentially with all references.

Illustrative material should include no more than 10 images with a resolution of at least 300 dots per inch, in JPEG or TIFF format.

Poster presentations, formatted uniformly by the conference organizers, can be purchased by the authors after the conference.
